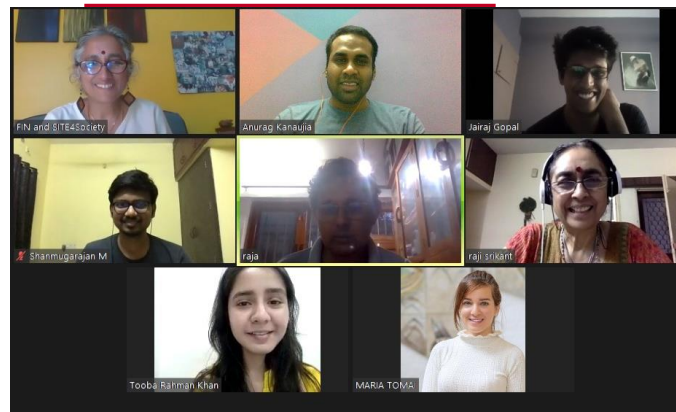


OBJECTIVE

P3: Is a Ph.D. in economics/management science for you? A training and testing program in scientific writing for 3 months to enter a Ph.D. program.

P4: Skilling for academic markets for doctoral students/early career academics in economics
A 5 months program to improve writing skills for publishing in international journals.
